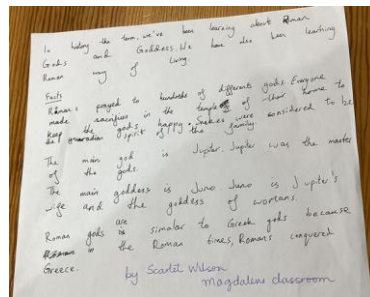
Forest School

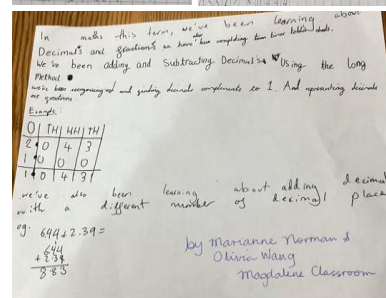
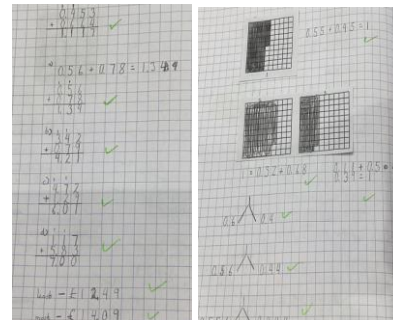
