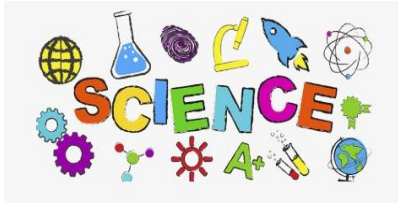




# APRIL in Year 3

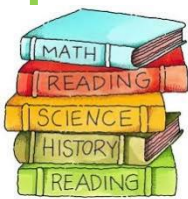

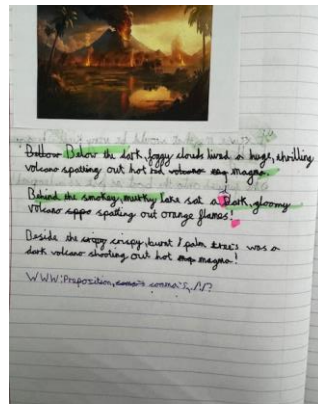
