
In English this month, we have begun our unit on portal stories where a character is transported to another place. We have looked at what makes a successful portal story and the use of prepositions to ensure we are moving the story along.

In grammar, we have been working on embedded clauses. This is a clause in the middle of the sentence in between 2 commas that you can remove, and your sentence still makes sense.

Ask your child what examples of portal stories they can think of!

In Art this half term, the children will have the opportunity to build their own mini building. We are looking at architecture, and the different styles of buildings we can see.
