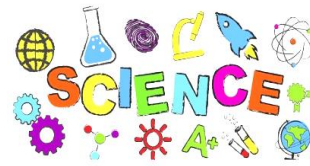

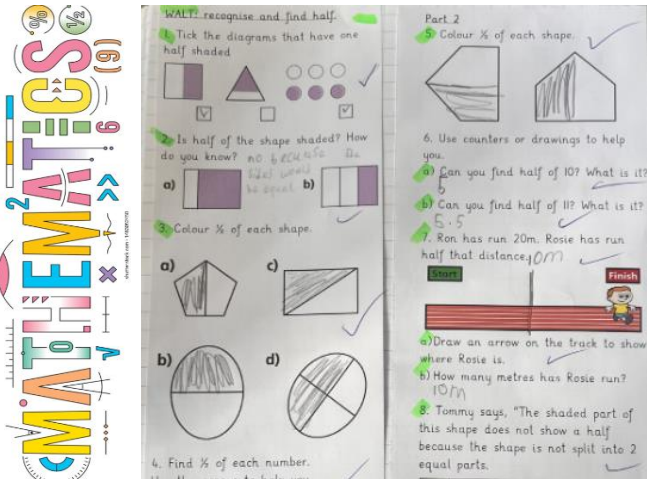
We hope you had a restful Easter break and are looking forward to the Summer Term!



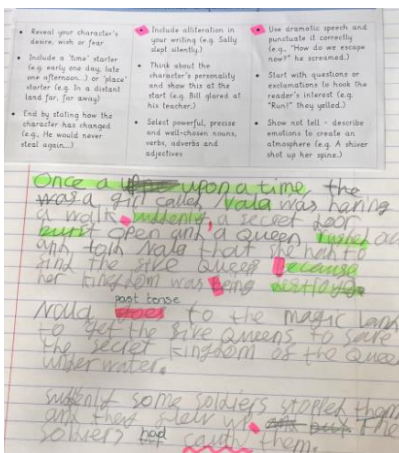
To begin our new Science topic on *rocks, fossils* and *soils*, we visited the Sedgwick Museum! We had a great time and it made us really excited to learn more.



In our lessons, we have discussed our prior knowledge and explored the three types of rocks - igneous, sedimentary and metamorphic.



To begin our *fractions* unit, we have revisited our prior learning. We have started by recognising halves ($\frac{1}{2}$) and quarters ($\frac{1}{4}$) in shapes, followed by finding these fractions in a number.



In English, we have started to explore *quest stories* and have used our toolkit to write our own based on *The Firework Maker's Daughter* by Philip Pullman. We are looking forward to learning and writing more this half term.
