We ask the following of volunteers:


To plan and resource a STEM activity of your choosing

In order to ensure your child's for entry into primary/infant school in September 2024, please note that applications must be completed and returned to the Admissions Team by the closing date of 15th January 2024. There are two ways to make your application for your school place. It can be done either:

On a paper application, available by calling 0345 045 1370.

Please note that if you apply on paper, you will need to wait for your postal offer, and will not receive an email on the offer date. Please note that if your child has a statement of Special Educational Needs, you should contact the Student Assessment Team (SAT team) on 01480 372600. If you submit an application after the closing date, it will be less likely that you are allocated your first choice of placement.
