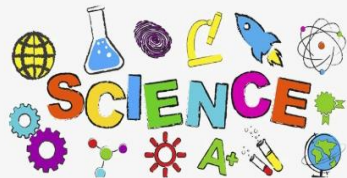




# November

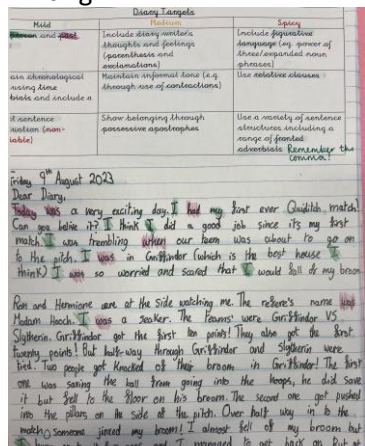

The children used a variety of skills to write about their first Quidditch match as if they were Harry Potter.

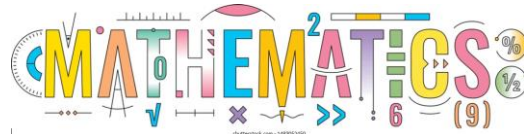
Here is a wonderful piece of writing:
