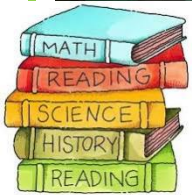




in Year 4

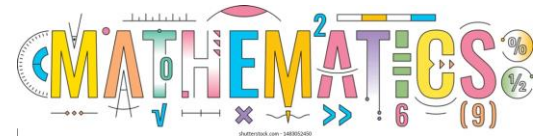
