Another busy week:

Class teachers have really enjoyed meeting the adults of the children that they teach; thank you to all those who were able to attend Meet the Teacher sessions. The information that was shared will be put up each class' Google Classroom. As ever, if you wish to speak to your child's class teacher, please contact the office to make an appointment or feel free to approach them on the playground at the end of the day. With this in mind, we do politely ask, that when children are being dropped off at school at the beginning of the day, adults remain on the playground and do not enter the school building. If there is an urgent issue that needs to be communicated, please speak to a member of SLT or inclusion team (present at the school gates).

Personal belongings in school:

Just a reminder that children should not be bringing in any toys or personal items from home. We are lucky that school is able to provide all the necessary classroom equipment and there is plenty of equipment available at playtimes through the OPAL project. Children are welcome to bring in reading books from home. Children in Years 5 and 6, who have written permission to walk home alone, may bring in a mobile phone for safety reasons. These phones are then collected by an adult at the beginning of the school day and stored safely in the office until home time.

Nursery places are still available:

There are still places available in the Nursery at Fawcett; a place entitles a child to 30 hours per week. These hours are free! Lunches are available at a cost of £2.50. To secure a place for your child, please contact the school office.
