We have been learning about our teeth.



We had fun using disclosing tablets to look at how well we clean our teeth! After that, we set up an experiment to see how liquids affect our teeth. We used eggs to represent our tooth enamel. Some of us guessed which liquid would cause the most damage to our enamel.

Playtimes after half term – all children will be going outside for playtime. Please make sure your child has wellies, waterproof coat and trousers. Thank you.






In Geography we have been finding out about different European countries. We created a list of countries and found out some of the capital cities.
