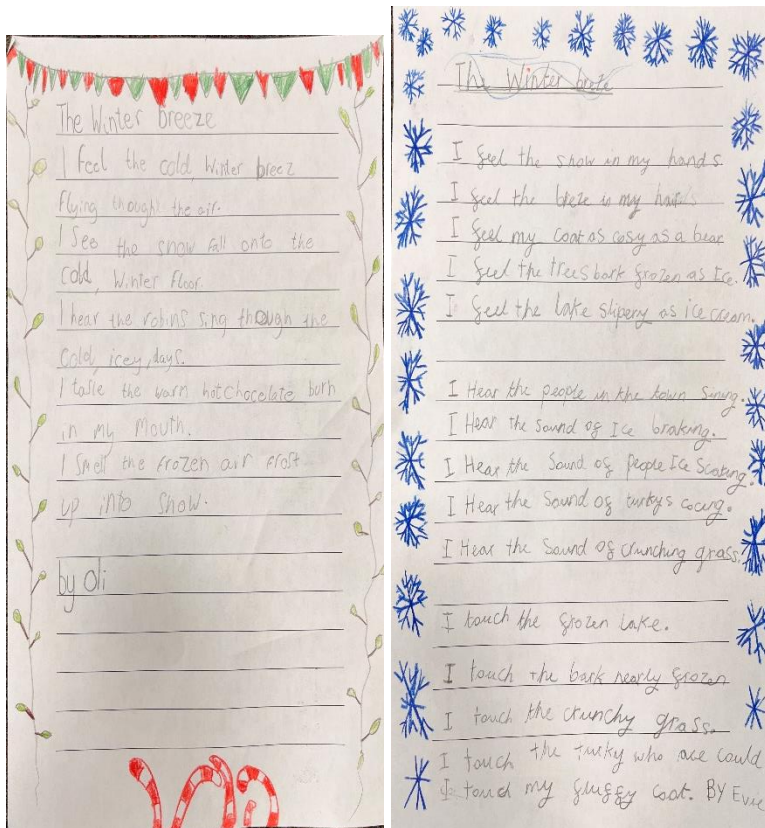

Well done to all of the children who have received certificates this month!

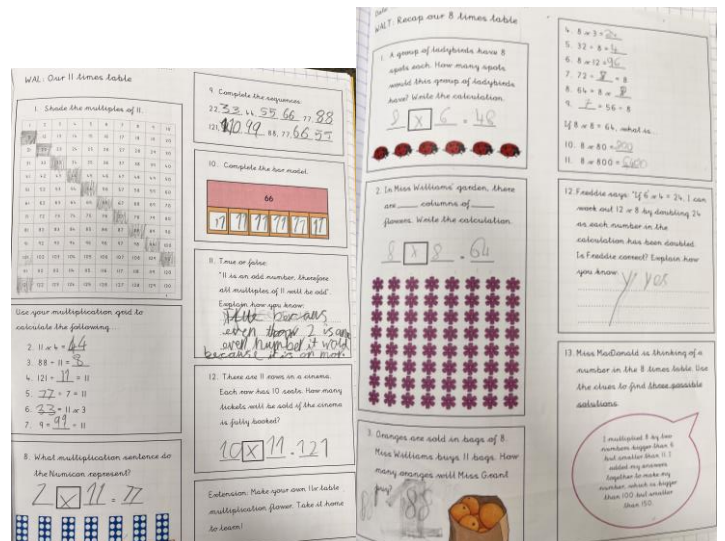
