Terms and Conditions

Opening Hours:

Morning Session

9 am - 12 midday

Afternoon Session 12 – 3 pm including lunch session

The nursery is closed during the school holidays and all bank/public holidays. Please see the school website for term dates and special school activities.

Session Options:

Option 1 All mornings 9 am – 12 o'clock	15 hours funded
Option 2 All afternoons 12 o'clock - 3 pm	15 hours funded including lunchtime
Option 3 Half week- Monday, Tuesday whole days (9 am- 3 pm) and Wednesday morning (9 am - 12 o'clock)	15 hours funded including lunchtime on Monday and Tuesday
Option 4 Half week -Wednesday afternoon (12 o'clock – 3 pm) and Thursday and Friday whole days (9 am – 3 pm)	15 hours funded including lunchtime on Thursday and Friday
Option 5 Whole days to make a full time week – (9 am – 3pm)	15 hours free plus 15 hours totalling £70.50 payable by you.

Payment

Fees effective from 1st Sept 2023 for additional hours above your free entitlement of 15 hours:

£4.70 per hour for purchased sessions over the 15 hour entitlement

Invoices will be issued on a monthly basis and must be settled within 14 days of receipt. In the event of non-payment we will issue a letter giving warning that if the fees are not paid within a further 7 days your child's place will be suspended.

Unfortunately, we have to charge for all the sessions your child is booked in to even if they are off sick or on holiday. This is so we can maintain correct child to adult ratios in the setting throughout the year.

Parents are required to give the school 4 weeks' notice in writing if their child no longer requires a nursery place.

Payment for school meals must be made via the online payment system or the school office. Please note we cannot accept childcare vouchers as payment for meals. This payment needs to be separate to any payments made for childcare.

Helping working parents save on childcare costs:
