

## in Year 1





This term in Science we have explored basic body parts. We have labelled the human body and described the main function of the body part. We particularly enjoyed making a 'paper person' and adding on the labels of the outside of the body. We have also talked about some inside body parts (brain, heart, lungs, bones and muscles) and discussed what they do.



In English, the children have enjoyed writing based on the text 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt.' We performed the story with actions and wrote sentences to describe what happened to the story.

More recently, we have been writing our own versions of 'The Three Little Pigs.' The children enjoyed changing the characters of the three little pigs and the wolf to different animals. In St. John's, we wrote about 'The Three Little Hedgehogs and the Big Bad Fox.' In St. Edmund's we wrote about 'The Three Little Fish and the Big Bad Shark.'



In History, we have begun our Explorer topic by looking at the achievements of Neil Armstrong – the first person on the moon.

In Religious Education, we have been learning about belonging to different communities – school, class and family.

In Computing, we have been learning about what the word 'technology' means.

During our PSHE lessons, we have discussed class rules, building relationships with other children in the class and discussed what it feels like to be new in school.
