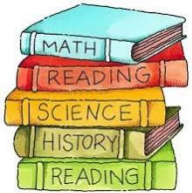


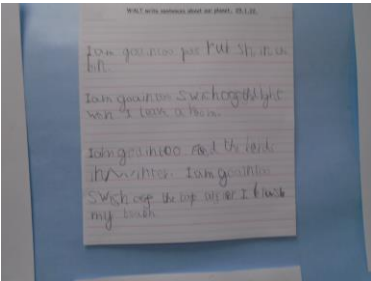
January in Year 1

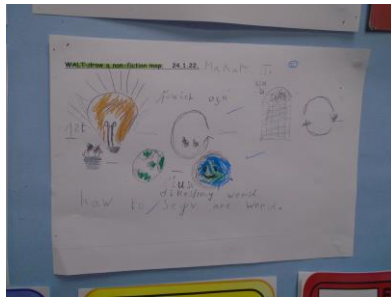

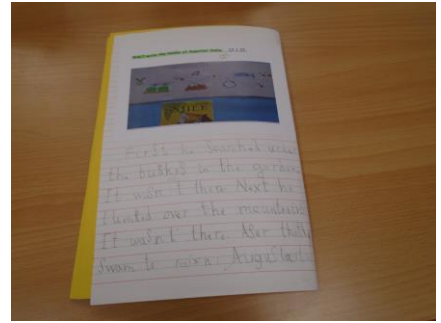


We have also been looking at a non-fiction text: 10 Ways to Save Our Planet.

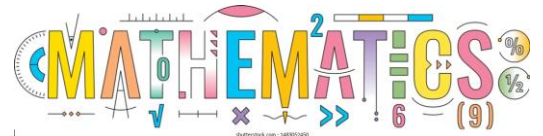
We have been writing about why we need to save our planet.



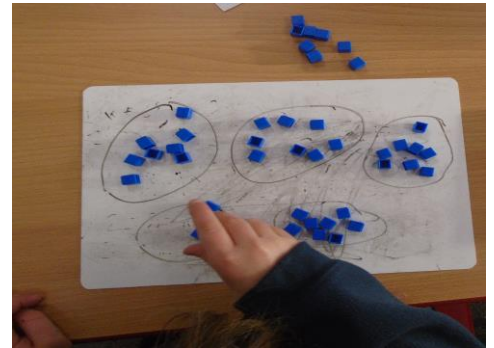
