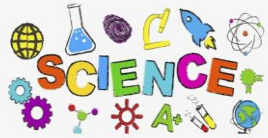
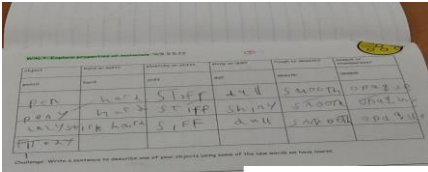




in Year One

This Month's Super Learners

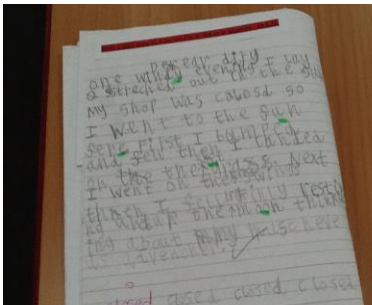
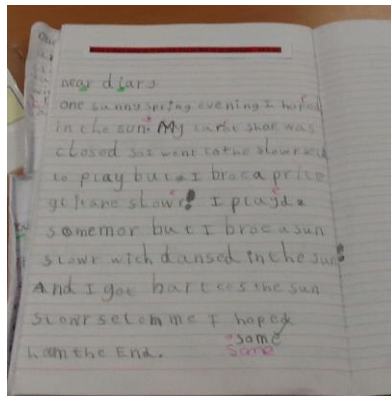
