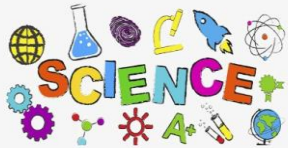
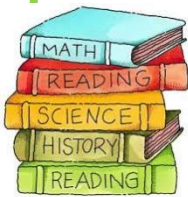
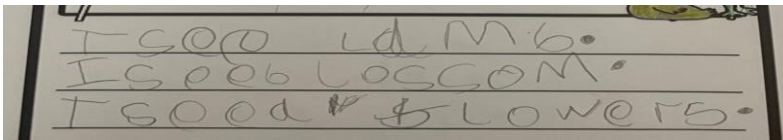


FEBRUARY in Year 1

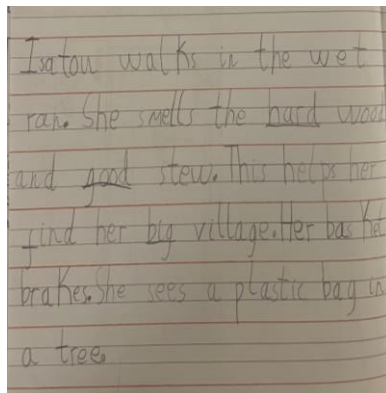

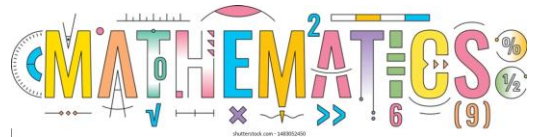
