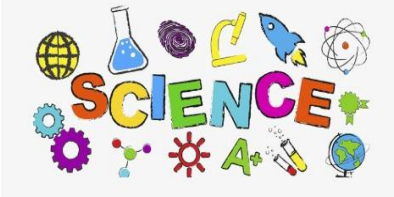
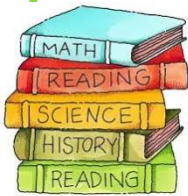




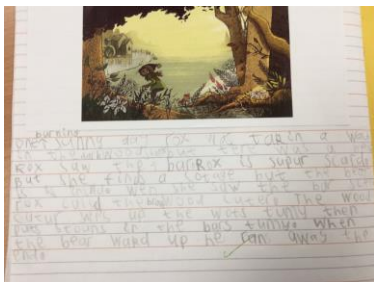
in Year 1

This month in Selwyn and Homerton classes we have been practising our letter formation. We have been having a weekly spelling test which has been helping with our spelling.



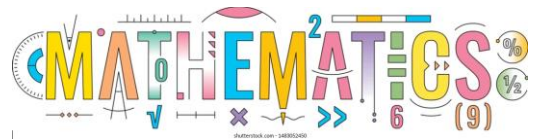
We have learnt the features of an information text and generated an extensive word bank of vocabulary on trees and plants.
