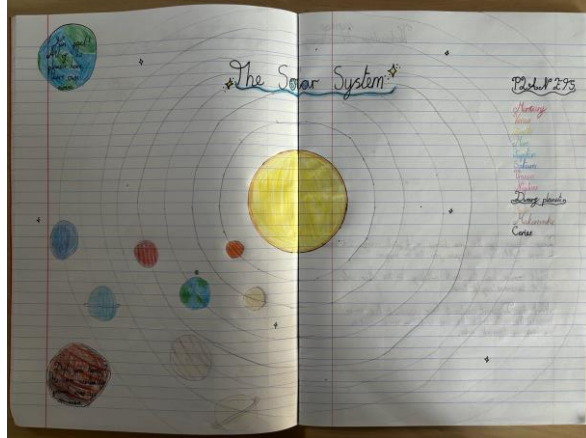

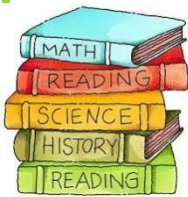

In English, we have been writing adventure stories.

We have written two adventure stories, making sure we are using our punctuation correctly, and our focus has been using speech appropriately.

We then moved on to explanation texts.

We hot-seated a character from our explanation text enabling us to really engage with our model text and considered the characters thoughts, feelings and actions.
