Updates

We have now completed our first term of OPAL play. It has been a great success – more children are loving being outside, no matter the weather, as there is now so much more to do.

In the last term we have introduced a number of areas which have extended the opportunities for play these include: a creative area, a reading area, a digging area and a mud kitchen. We have also introduced large loose parts such as pallets, cable reels, barrels, planks and tyres which the children have been enjoying using to make dens and other creative things. We have a new boom box to use so we can have music on the playground – this is really exciting!

Through this kind of play not only are children more active at play times but they are also having the opportunity to further develop life skills such as cooperation, team work and problem solving. They are becoming motivated and enthusiastic builders, engineers, explorers and designers.
