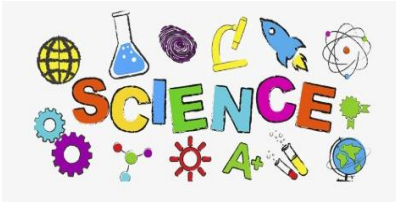




in Year 1

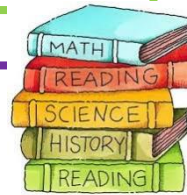

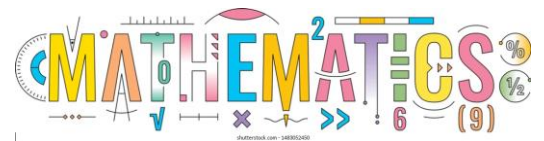
In History, we have begun our Explorer topic by looking at the achievements of Neil Armstrong – the first person on the Moon.

In Art, we have been looking at spirals and how we can use our body to draw a spiral.

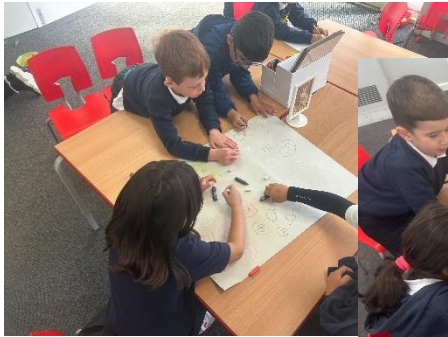

In our lessons, we have been practicing forming our numbers in the correct direction and spelling numbers to 10 in words. We have practically made numbers to 10 and identified what is one more and one less of the given number.

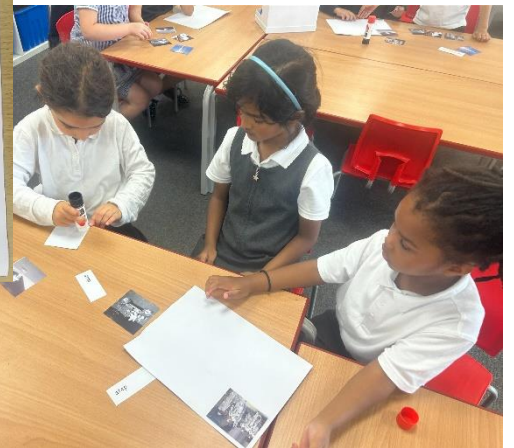
