Absences:

If you are reporting an absence due to illness, please could you inform the office by 10am. Your child's absence can be reported via Studybugs or by phoning or emailing the school office. Please can you contact the office for each day that your child is absent.

Request for absence: This can be made through the office for exceptional circumstances such as family celebrations, bereavement or religious holidays. However, please note that term time leave will not be authorised by the school. If you choose to take your child out of school during term time for 6 consecutive sessions of more, you may receive a penalty notice. One day is 2 sessions.

Wrap around care reminder:

We run a Breakfast Club from **7:50 to 8:40am** each day; which is a drop in service (no need to book), and an After School Club from **3:10 – 5:45pm**. If you wish to secure a place for your child, please contact the office for a booking form. Places must be allocated; children may not attend unless they have a confirmed place.
