


## in Year 3



In science, our topic has been forces. We started off by thinking about what makes things move and enjoyed finding out about friction.









In English, we have been learning about how to write instructions. Our model text is "How to wash a Woolly Mammoth" – we don't think we would have enough room at home to do this!
