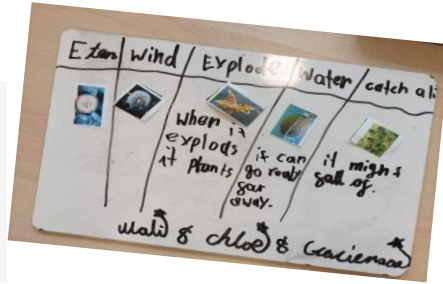
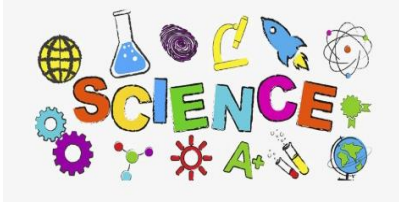
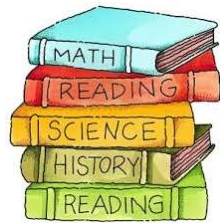




in Year 3 ...

In our English, we have enjoyed taking on the role of a reporter. By studying newspaper features and listening to real events recounted on Newsround, we have learned how to write successful news reports capturing the attention of the reader through the use of catchy headlines, the 5 w's (Who?
