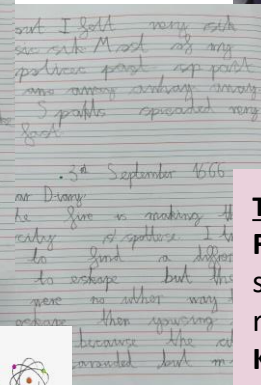
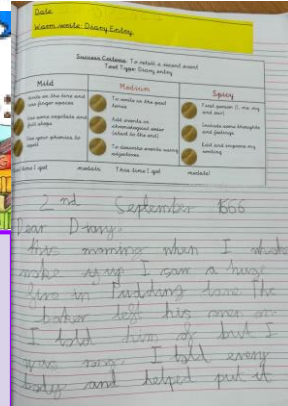
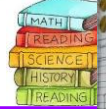


JANUARY
