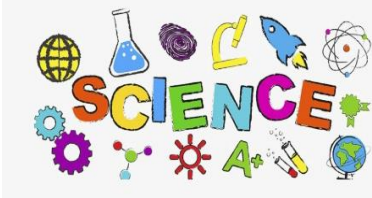

Additionally, children have shown a keen interest in investigating food miles and how far their food has come to be on their plates.

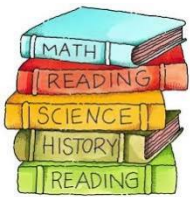

The brilliant writing skills in Year 4 have been highlighted through their assessed pieces, showcasing their excellent use of vocabulary and ability to build vivid descriptions.

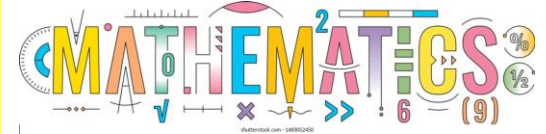
Our final unit of writing has been based on the River Cam. Creating information texts to reflect the history and physical geographical features of the river.
