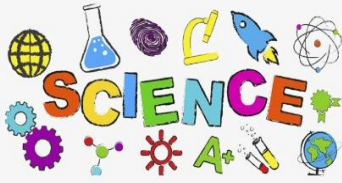
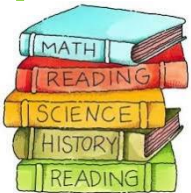
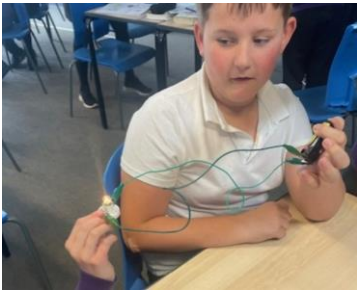




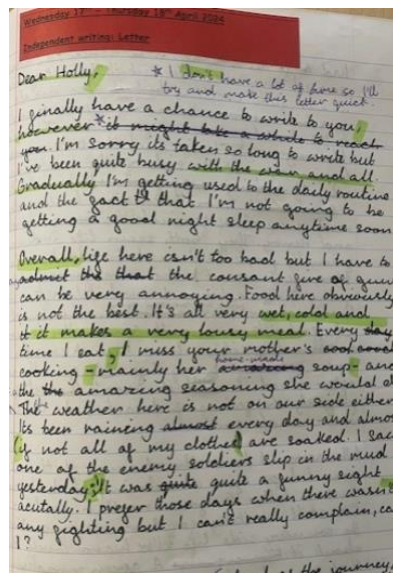
APRIL in Year 6



In Science, we have started our topic on electricity. We have reminded ourselves of the names of the different components of an electrical circuit and explored how voltage affects these components – the children built their own circuits to support their investigations.



In English, the children have completed their first assessed write – an emotive letter. We recapped a range of techniques, such as: using expanded noun phrases to describe and semi-colon list sentences to add detail. Each week, we will be recapping a previous writing genre and the children will have an opportunity to plan, write and edit their work independently.



Design & Technology

We have started our new unit aptly named, Take a Seat, where the children will be designing and creating their own small-scale chairs. We have started by looking at the work of some chair designers and the children have taken visual notes to use as inspiration in their own designs.



We have been working on our last unit of the national curriculum, statistics. The children have been building on their graph reading skills looking at line and bar graphs as well as pie charts.

Following this, we have started our revision for SATS. We are practicing the key mathematical skills that the children in our class find tricky.
