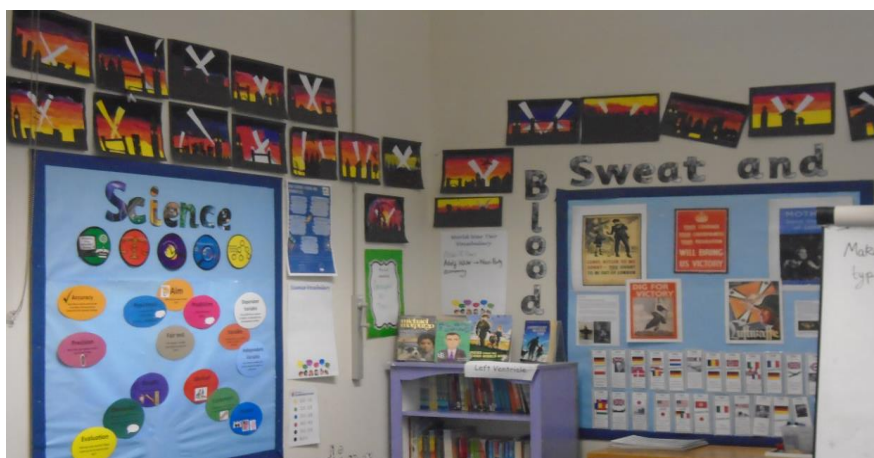


Open Classrooms:
