Changes to Secondary School Admissions:

If you are planning to apply for a place at either Chesterton Community College or Parkside Community College for Year 7 entry in September 2026, please read the guidance on the County Council website Secondary school admissions - September 2026 | Cambridgeshire County Council

Both schools are in the process of making changes to their admissions criteria, and places will be allocated on the basis of their new admissions criteria, which are due to be published by 30 September. We don't yet know what these changes will be.

If you are interested in either of these two schools, please review your application between 30 September and the 31 October submission deadline for school applications - in case you are affected by the changes in admissions criteria.
