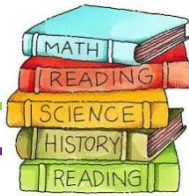


# JANUARY

# in Year 3



In this learning topic, children are exploring the different parts of plants and understanding their importance and functions. They are identifying and labelling the key parts of a flower, and learning how each contributes to the plant's life cycle.



Children are working hard to expand their vocabulary and identify key features of mystery stories. They are focusing on describing how a character feels by engaging the senses and using fronted adverbials to enhance their writing. Additionally, they are learning to show how a character's emotions change throughout the story, adding depth to their narratives.

**History** - Pupils are diving into the fascinating world of ancient civilizations- Ancient Sumer; The Indus Valley; The Shang Dynasty of Ancient China, with a

special focus on Ancient Egypt.

They are exploring the rich culture, remarkable achievements, and daily lives of the Egyptians, including their innovations in farming, writing, and architecture. Through studying the pyramids, hieroglyphics, and the significance of the River Nile, the children are uncovering how this civilization shaped the ancient world.

In Year 3, children are developing their understanding of multiplication and division through practical methods. They are multiplying two-digit numbers by one-digit numbers using the grid method, which helps them break down calculations into manageable steps.

For division, they are using a number line to divide two-digit numbers by one-digit numbers, building their confidence in visualizing and solving problems. These approaches not only strengthen their calculation skills but also enhance their conceptual understanding of how numbers relate to each other.
