Continuous professional development (CPD) is something we take very seriously at the Federation and all staff undergo regular training to develop their skills and improve our practice. Recently, we have adjusted the way we teach reading in school and teachers have observed each other and reflected on this, whilst including evidence-based practice into how we teach children to read fluently. If your children come home and talk about 'echo reading', for example, this will be one of the strategies we are using to develop this area. Ms Robitaille, in Year 4, is taking part in a local authority project aimed at developing practice in fluency across Cambridgeshire and the findings from this research will then be brought directly into our classrooms.
