News from the Federation – 20th December 2024



As we reach the Christmas break, I thought I would write a little about the work that goes on behind the scenes to support all staff in fulfilling their roles as well as they can. Ongoing training for staff is a priority of the Federation and we have a programme of meetings, for teachers and teaching assistants, focused on our priority development areas (for example, reading and phonics, curriculum developments, supporting pupils with SEND). Teachers have all completed 'lesson study' this term where they observe each other and identify strengths and development areas in their practice.

This term, we have also had visits from the local authority to review our provision in Nursery, which was very positive and has given us some useful pointers on how to further enhance what we offer, and advisors in Maths and English who work alongside our subject leaders to review and develop our teaching. Ms Robitaille is working with a local authority advisor on new approaches to the teaching of fluency in reading, whilst we have also had visits from our OPAL advisor so we can continue to improve our outdoor provision. All staff have had annual safeguarding training whilst some of our teachers and leaders are completing, or have already completed, NPQs (national professional qualifications) in teaching, senior leadership or headship.

Improving what we offer at Trumpington Meadows is always an objective and much happens once the children have left the school to help make this happen. Please can I wish you all a very restful and enjoyable Christmas break – we look forward to seeing the children back on Tuesday 7th January.
