In Science, we have continued learning about seasonal changes, focusing on Winter. We have talked about the months that are in Winter, what the weather is like, events and celebrations, what happens to plants and animals and clothes we wear to keep warm.



In Geography, we have made maps of the playground to highlight some of the human and physical features.

In RE, we have been learning about the Christmas story.

In English, we have been writing letters. In Maths this month we have focused on place value with numbers to 20. We have made numbers to 20 using different manipulatives such as Numicon, bead strings and tens frames. We have used dienes and part-whole models to identify the tens and ones in 2-digit numbers. We have been finding one more and one less than a given number, comparing numbers and ordering numbers.

We have also revisited addition using a number line, number bonds to 10 and the 1 times table.
