Thank you to all the parents that joined us to celebrate.

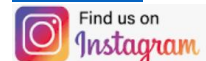


#### Nursery Stay and Play

## Online Safety

We would like to remind you of the guidance and regulations around social media and to raise the awareness of potential negative interactions children can be having online and also the potential dangers. Although this activity is not happening on the school site, it affects the behaviour, friendships, and subsequently lesson time and the learning of pupils in school. There is clear guidance on the appropriate age ranges for certain online apps and we would like to draw your attention to these below. Most social media services require users to be at least 13 years of age to access and use their services. This includes Facebook, Snapchat, WhatsApp, Twitter, Instagram and Tik Tok. Whilst there is no age restriction for watching videos on YouTube, users need to be 13 or older to have their own YouTube account (enabling them to subscribe to other channels, like videos, post comments, share their own content and flag inappropriate content). The online world is a minefield for children and the situation has changed significantly in the last 10-15 years, as a whole range of unlimited content, both good and bad, is a few clicks away. Once something has been posted on social media, it is very hard to get rid of. We do not advocate the use of social media for primary aged children and would advise parents therefore, to be vigilant and closely monitor their child/ren's activity on electronic devices and social media.
