

Spelling Activities

-Mild and Medium

- Choose one activity per day and choose four words daily, from the year 1 (**Mild**) or year 2 (**Medium**) common exception word list. (Year 2 pupils should know all the year 1 and year 2 common exception words)
- Tick the words and the activity once you have completed it and be sure to give each activity a try!

<p>SILLY SENTENCES Write extended silly sentences using a spelling word in each sentence. Please underline your spelling words and remember to write neatly!</p>	<p>RAINBOW WORDS First write each word in pencil. Then trace over each word three times. Each time you trace, you must use a DIFFERENT coloured pencil. Trace neatly and you will see a rainbow!</p>	<p>PYRAMID WRITING "Pyramid write" your spelling words. Remember to write neatly! Example: home h ho hom home</p>
<p>WORDSEARCH Make a wordsearch puzzle using your spelling words. <i>Remember to write the words at the side.</i> You could challenge a member of your family to see if they can find all your words!</p>	<p>SPELL WORDS BACKWARDS Write your spelling words correctly and then try writing them backwards.</p>	<p>ACROSTIC POEM Choose three of your spelling words. Write an acrostic poem for each word. You may also like to <i>illustrate</i> your poem.</p>
<p>UPPER CASE and LOWER CASE Write your words once each in upper case and then write them again in lower case. HIDDEN WORDS Hide your spelling words in a picture.</p>	<p>WORDS within WORDS Write each spelling word and then write at least two words made from the same letters that is hidden inside the word. Example: slide side lie lid led etc.</p>	<p>TOSS A WORD Toss (or roll) a ball back and forth with a partner. You say the 1st letter, and then toss and your partner says the 2nd letter, etc.</p>
<p>CHOO CHOO WORDS Draw a train and put a word in each carriage. BUBBLE WRITING Write your spelling words in bubble writing. FANCY LETTERS Write your words in fancy letters.</p>	<p>BUZZING BEES Draw and colour an outdoor picture. Count your spelling words. Draw a bee for each of your spelling words then write the words inside each of the "spelling" bees. Remember to write neatly!</p>	<p>COLOURFUL VOWELS You will need a coloured pencil. Write each of your spelling words and trace over the vowels in each word with your coloured pencil. Vowels = a e i o u</p>
<p>SECRET CODE Number the alphabet from 1-26. Example: a=1, b=2, c=3, etc. Then convert your words to a number code. You must write the actual spelling word next to the "code word".</p>	<p>SPELLING FLOWERS Draw a picture of a flower. Write each of your spelling words on one of the flower petals or on a leaf. Draw extra flowers if you run out of room.</p>	<p>SENTENCES PLEASE Write sentences using each of your spelling words. You may use more than one word in a sentence. Remember to <u>underline</u> your spelling words.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">MNEMONICS</p> <p>Make a mnemonic for each of your spelling words.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">HIDDEN WORDS</p> <p>Hide your spelling words in a picture.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">CROSSWORD</p> <p>Create a crossword with all your words.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">ACROSTIC</p> <p>Create an acrostic poem for 4 of your words.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">CREATE A POSTER</p> <p>Create a poster that would help other children remember some of the tricky words.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">STORY, STORY</p> <p>Write a story using ALL of your spelling words. Be sure to <u>underline</u> your spelling words in your paragraph.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">I KNOW MY ALPHABET</p> <p>Carefully read all your spelling words and write them in alphabetical order.</p> <p>Write them in a list with a definition like a dictionary!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">PYRAMID WRITING</p> <p>“Pyramid write” your spelling words. Remember to write neatly!</p> <p>Example: home h ho hom home</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">SUPERMAN LETTER</p> <p>Your job is to write a letter to Superman (or any other super hero) asking for help. In your letter, you must use each of your spelling words for the week. Be sure to <u>underline</u> your words as you use them.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">MAGAZINE/NEWSPAPER WORDS</p> <p>Use an old magazine and find your words (or the letters that make up your word). Cut them out and glue them in a book or on paper.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">RIDDLES</p> <p>Write a riddle for each of your spelling words. Don't forget to add the answers to your riddles!</p> <p>Example: I cry when I am hungry. I wear nappies. I am cute and cuddly. What am I? Answer: Baby.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">ADDING MY WORDS</p> <p>Each letter has a value.</p> <p>*Consonants are worth 10 points.</p> <p>*Vowels are worth 5 points.</p> <p>Write your spelling words. Then add up the value of each spelling word.</p> <p>Example: said: 10 + 5 + 5 + 10 = 30</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">RHYMING</p> <p>Write your spelling words in a list. Create a second list of rhyming words for each of your spelling words.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">TIME YOUR SPELLING</p> <p>Write your words as neatly as you can and time yourself. Write them again and see if you can write them correctly and neatly faster the second time.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Try a third time!</p>
