With the help of many dedicated volunteers from the Trumpington Community, they have packed supplies to send to the war zone to help those who have been affected. Thank you, to the very generous people of Trumpington who have been delivering packages to Alicja and helping prepare boxes throughout the week in readiness for delivery.

If anyone in the Trumpington Community would like to make any further donations, they can be dropped off at either school. Deliveries to Poland and Ukraine will be made every few days until the situation changes.

In particular things that are needed are - baby milk/food, nappies, sanitary towels, medical supplies including bandages, surgical spirit, painkillers, antibacterial fluids, non-perishable food (instant soup etc.), energy bars, dried fruit, canned meat/fish, pasta, oats, batteries, torches, microfiber towels, razors, toothpaste, toothbrushes, masks (disposable and reusable) sleeping bags, thermal blankets, military mattresses, pillows, cooking cauldrons, field tents, paper towels and raincoats.
