

FEBRUARY In Year 2

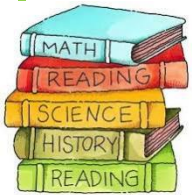

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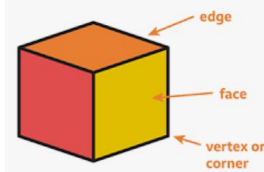
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We enjoyed making tally marks and block charts at the end of last term.
