

News from the Federation – 18th March 2022

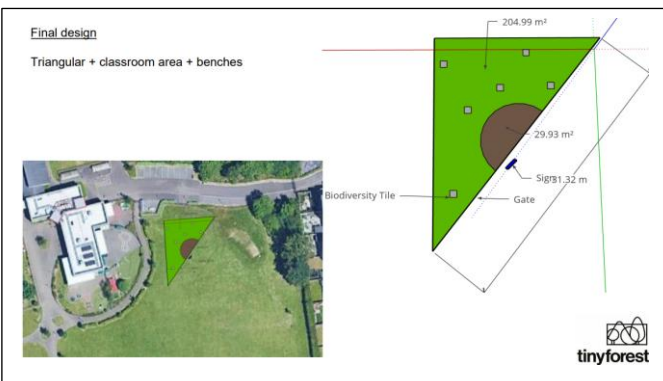
