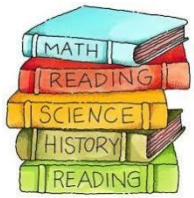

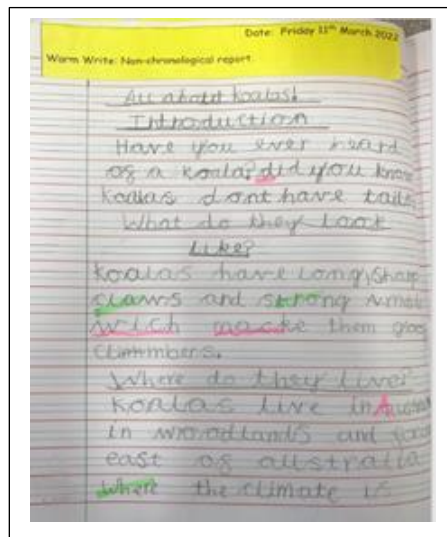
This Month's Super Learners
