Sickness & Absence Reporting

If your child/children are not coming into school due to sickness, please call or email the school office as early as you can and definitely before 10am providing us with a reason for the absence – you need to contact the school every day of your child's/children's absence (not just on the first day) until they return. If you need to take your child out of school for any other reason, please obtain an 'absence request' form from the school office. All school absences have to be recorded and not telling the school of an absence could result in the absence being recorded as 'unauthorised'; which goes against your child's/children's attendance record.

Learning environment

This week we had a visitor from the Local Authority, who came to look around the school, she has the privilege of visiting many schools throughout Cambridgeshire. She was really impressed with what she saw and how calm and purposeful the children were; she made particular comments about how the school looked and how it felt, describing it as having a warmth and a heart.
