

TASK - Who was Queen Victoria?

Find out about Queen Victoria. You can choose how to present your research. You could create a fact-file, information poster or even a Powerpoint presentation - it's up to you. You could present your findings to the rest of your household and/or send them to a relative.

We have put some information to help you on the website, but you might also be able to find further information yourself using books you have at home or websites.

Here is a suggested list of things you might want to think about to start you off but you don't need to stick to this.

- Important dates - Birth, death, coronation etc
- Family - parents, children, husband.
- Where did she live?
- What was she like? What did she enjoy/dislike?
- Empire
- What is she remembered for?
- Fascinating facts/Trivia
- What is the most interesting thing that you learnt about her?
- Include some pictures/illustrations

Spend some time over the next couple of weeks researching, then presenting your information.
